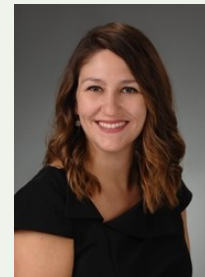

ISBE Issues Guidance on Virtual Summer School

Based on Governor Pritzker's Restore Illinois' phased reopening plan and the placement of schools in Phase 4, summer school programming will be conducted virtually. The Illinois State Board of Education has issued [Guidance](#) on conducting summer classes and programming virtually. The Guidance provides districts with strategies to maximize summer school learning. Additionally, it includes a reminder that under the School Code, in order to award high school credit for summer school, students must complete 60 hours of instructional time, and includes some options for how those 60 hours can be completed during e-learning.
