ILLINOIS ENACTS NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES AND OFFICIALS

The Governor has signed into law new Public Act 99-0604 entitled "Local Government Travel Expense Control Act" (the "Act"). The Act applies to school districts and local governments other than home rule units. In order for employees or officers of school districts or local governments to be reimbursed for "travel" expenses, the Act requires the creation of written regulations for the reimbursement of such expenses. Under the Act, this includes travel, meal, and lodging expenses.
